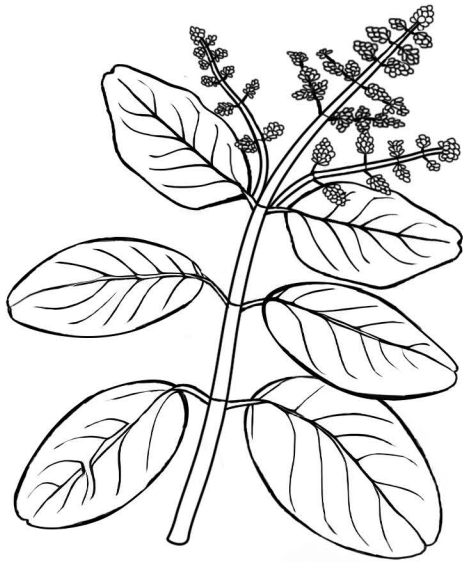


KEEPING NORTH CAROLINA'S FORESTS HEALTHY

Invasive exotic plants are transported outside their normal ranges and cause damage or harm in new locations. Many invasive species can spread rampantly, displace natural plant species and become nuisances. Chinese privet, cogongrass, bamboo and silvergrass are invasive plants. One solution to prevent the spread of invasives is to landscape with native plants.
